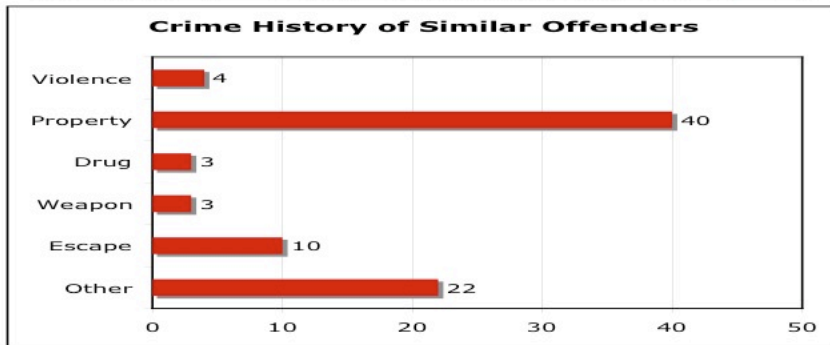
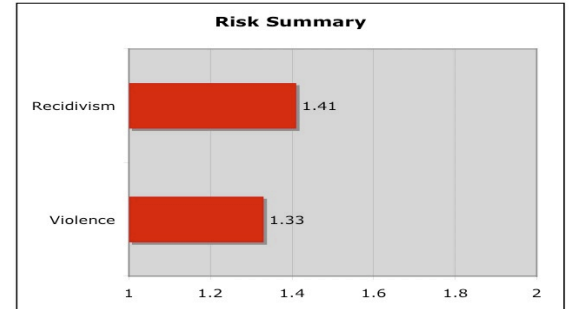
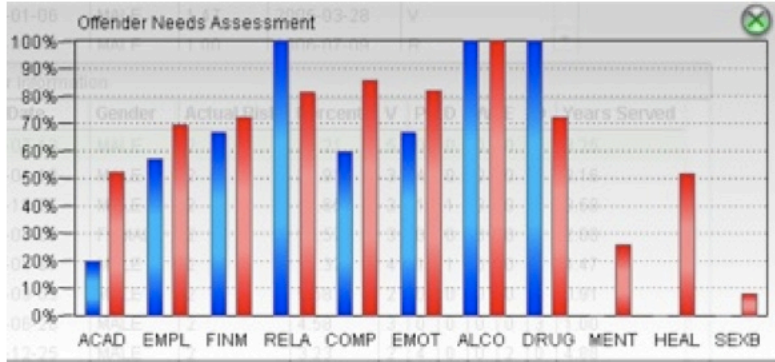

The Risk Management System (RMS) represents the first fifth generation Risk and Needs assessment tool. RMS takes advantage of the common sense notion that an offender's risk depends on the type of risk factors they present, not just a score. Using advanced modeling techniques, RMS examines an offender's risk factor pattern to create a simulation of the risk posed to the community. Quite simply, RMS overcomes the limitations of traditional summed-scored risk assessment approaches.

In addition, because RMS constructs a model of how an offender's risk factor pattern interacts and links it directly to empirical outcomes you can play "What-If?" Why? Because you can test which criminogenic need is likely to be linked to future recidivism reduction and how to reduce that risk. If you've seen another tool that can do this, let us know!
